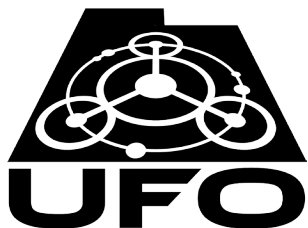

STEPHEN GALLAGHER

Winner of British Fantasy and International Horror Guild Awards, Stephen Gallagher is the author of fifteen novels including *Valley of Lights* and *The Bedlam Detective*. Stephen's resume includes an impressive list of screenwriting credits, such as two seasons of 'classic era' *Doctor Who*, NBC's *Crusoe*, the thriller *Chimera*, and CBS series *Eleventh Hour*. He'll be joining us from his home in Lancashire, England.



DAVID CHERRY

David Cherry is an award-winning artist whose work has graced the covers of countless books, trading cards, and the walls of collectors of fine science fiction and fantasy artwork. He is a past president of The Association of Science Fiction and Fantasy Artists. He has received 8 Chesley Awards and has been nominated for 16 more.



ANNE GROELL

A native New Yorker and former biologist, Anne Lesley Groell has worked in sf/f publishing for more than twenty-six years. She is an Executive Editor for Penguin Random House, and a member of Team Del Rey, where she works with such authors as George R.R. Martin, Terry Brooks, Naomi Novik and Robin Hobb.



C.J. CHERRYH

C. J. Cherryh, has written more than 80 books since the mid-1970s, including the Hugo Award-winning novels *Downbelow Station* (1981) and *Cyteen* (1988). She is known for world-building, for depicting fictional realms with great realism. Her series of fantasy novels set in the Alliance-Union universe, the Morgaine Stories, have sold in excess of 3 million copies.



STEPHEN GRAHAM JONES

Stephen Graham Jones' work has received the Independent Publishers Award for Multicultural Fiction, a Bram Stoker Award, and four This is Horror Awards. His novel, *Mapping the Interior*, was a finalist for the 2018 World Fantasy Award. He has two books being released in the spring of 2020: *Night of the Mannequins* (Tor.com) and *The Only Good Indians* (Saga Press.)



CINDY PON

Cindy Pon's debut novel, *Silver Phoenix*, was named one of the Top Ten Fantasy and Science Fiction Books for Youth by the American Library Association's Booklist and one of 2009's best by VOYA. Her most recent, *WANT* and *RUSE*, are action-packed thrillers set in a futuristic Taiwan. She is a co-founder of Diversity in YA and serves on the advisory board of We Need Diverse Books.



BRANDON SANDERSON

Brandon Sanderson's novels include the Mistborn books, *The Stormlight Archive*, *The Rithmatist*, *Steelheart*, and his most recent bestseller *Starsight*, book two in the Skyward series, among others. He completed the final volumes of Robert Jordan's The Wheel of Time series and is published in 35 languages. Brandon also teaches creative writing at Brigham Young University.



TRACY AND LAURA HICKMAN

Tracy and Laura Hickman are co-authors of the Bronze Canticles Trilogy. Tracy is also the author of numerous books, including over forty titles with co-author Margaret Weiss, beginning with the well-known Dragonlance Chronicles. They will serve as WFC 2020's Toastmasters.



PROGRAM PLANNING UNDERWAY

One of the things that makes World Fantasy Convention unique among other conventions is the exceptional number of professionals that comprise its membership. When a huge percentage of attendees to the annual gathering are multi-published in the genre, that makes for a first-rate program. Panelists are selected from among the attendees. All nominated material must have been published in 2019 or have a 2019 cover date. Only living persons may be nominated.

When listing stories or other material that may not be familiar to all the judges, please include pertinent information such as author, editor, Publisher/Source, magazine name and date, etc.

NOMINATIONS

You may nominate up to five items in each category, in no particular order. You don't have to nominate items in every category, but you must nominate in more than one. The items are not point-rated. The two items receiving the most nominations (except for those ineligible) will be placed on the final ballot. The remainder are added by the judges.

THE AWARDS ARE PRESENTED AT THE WORLD FANTASY CONVENTION BANQUET.



OUR VENUE

World Fantasy Convention 2020 will be held at The Little America Hotel, located at 500 South Main Street in downtown Salt Lake City. The hotel is Salt Lake's most luxurious four-diamond hotel. Tower rooms are located in a 17-story high-rise with stunning views of either the downtown area or the surrounding mountains. Tower rooms are available for \$189 USD per night, plus applicable fees and taxes (12.6% currently.) In addition, the hotel grounds offer rooms in two-story Garden rooms surrounding beautifully landscaped grounds. The rate for Garden rooms is \$169 USD plus taxes. Note that convention programming will take place in the Tower.

Within walking distance of the hotel are countless restaurants, bars, shopping, attractions, and historical sites. Don't feel like walking? Hop on TRAX, the city's light rail transportation system. There's a stop on the corner just outside the hotel, in the "free zone" serving the downtown area. Wi-fi is complimentary in the guest rooms. Self-parking at the hotel is free of charge, while valet parking is available to convention members for the prevailing fee at time of check-in.

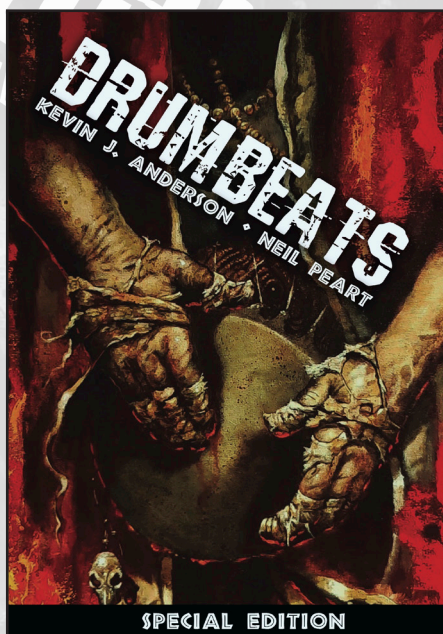
We collect your information to allow the convention committee and staff to provide you better services. Your personal information will be kept strictly confidential. We will ask your consent before sharing your information with anyone outside this convention committee.

1. We must retain records relating to member registration and financial transactions. Other than this obligation, at a user's request, we will remove any information about the user from all online systems after the WFC 2022 convention.
2. Contact information will be shared with the next two World Fantasy Conventions to allow our members the right to exercise their World Fantasy nomination rights. If you do not want your information shared with future conventions, please indicate that on your registration form.
3. Member financial payment information, e.g. credit card numbers, does not come to us through online payment systems (PayPal and Square); such information is handled exclusively by the online payment service. (We utilize only Payment Card Industry (PCI) compliant companies when processing your credit cards.) Credit card information submitted physically (through a signed credit card slip) is kept secure and is not shared with anyone or used for any purpose other than the membership or other transaction requested by the member. Any physical copies of credit card information are shredded as soon as the payment has been finalized.
